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VARIATION GROVES SYNDROME

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The hostility syndrome patients Groves always visiting professional associates, however we have seen a variant of the families of the people who are in treatment; Here we discuss the situation of the family with regard to children and adolescents with learning difficulties being re-educated.

Describe manifests first as general syndrome Groves, hostile attitudes affected that alter the relationship, without actually suffering a psychiatric condition causing against negative transfer (hatred, fears or dislikes) in professional they treat them.

As in the process of the patients three different levels of event are observed:

The first is the family that overwhelm with questions, phone calls, repeated requests for interviews accompanied by lengthy explanations about the difficulties of his son.

The motivations for this behavior of the family is often different for each family, depending on the degree of anxiety in general if family members are able to take the needs of their children tend to be moderate in their behavior, at other times when they want a quick fix the problem is when they appear restless behavior and for protection, so the long conversations that should be given, we believe are beneficial because they help a relationship friendly between professionals and family members.

The second level is typically discuss with my on the tasks in an equal and sometimes an attempt to impose their judgment without considering the professional, often causing confusion and misunderstanding.

In very specific situations often have a family expectations about the time needed for rehabilitation, when these are not met with a hostile tendency toward professionals, manifested as shown in the second level. The appropriate approach is to try to understand what those expectations, and if they are viable if they are possible to explain the reasons for which have not yet been met, providing them all the information possible. .

The third level is the typical hide information, data or breach the various recommendations that are provided, this causes serious difficulties in the process of re-education.

At this level, there is a component of great fear, that in some situations leads to situations of confusion, the family in this situation usually displayed partners whenever they think that the information will not affect them in some way, for example, it may happen that some family think that it may affect their dignity to explain certain things, the solution is to provide maximum confidence.

The above is not always expressed in all families, only in specific situations, sometimes only have a level that we expose, showing there exceptional occasions all levels.

On occasion we have seen people who have shown so ordered the three levels in three different time periods.

We believe it is important, as far as possible, that when observing these manifestations professional psychological support for the family is suggested, that would be the way to release pressure and professional to perform the task correctly.
